

Important logistical information regarding the 2025 Abuse-Free Sport Research Symposium

In preparation for the 2025 Abuse-Free Sport Research Symposium in Winnipeg next week, we are pleased to provide you with the following practical information:

Symposium Venue - The Symposium will be held at the Canadian Museum for Human Rights, located at 85 Israel Asper Way, Winnipeg, MB R3C 0L5. All sessions will be held in the Classroom Foyer. More information about the Museum can be found <u>here</u>.

Accommodation - The Inn at the Forks hotel is located at 75 Forks Market Road, Winnipeg, MB, R3C 0A2. Check-in after 3:00 p.m. and check-out by 11:00 a.m. You will be required to provide a credit card upon check-in.

Getting There - From the Winnipeg Richardson International Airport (YWG), the easiest way to get to the Inn at the Forks or to the Museum is by taxi or Uber (approximately \$20-\$30) as they are approximately 11 km away. Parking - For local participants coming by car, parking options near the Museum include paid parking located on Israel Asper Way, William Stephenson Way, and Waterfront Drive, as well as surface lots and parkades located off these streets. There is no designated or free Museum parking.

Dress Code - We suggest business casual attire for the Symposium.

Symposium Schedule and Information - Please ensure that you respect the timing of each session. The program is very full and we need your cooperation to ensure that sessions start and end on time. Please note that we will not be providing any printed copies of the Symposium materials. Simultaneous Interpretation - The majority of the sessions will be delivered in English with the exception of Session 8 which will have some French content. Simultaneous interpretation will be available through Zoom for all sessions. If you wish to use simultaneous interpretation services during the Symposium, <u>please bring</u>:

- A pair of headphones;
- > A device (i.e., phone, laptop, tablet) that you can connect to Zoom on.

Registration - Registration will be held in the Classroom Foyer on February 24, 2025 from 8:00 to 9:00 a.m.
